

## Equine Preventative Health Care Plan



2 months old: Intestinal Parasite Deworming

4 months old: Intestinal Parasite Deworming

5-6 months old: Intestinal Parasite Deworming  
1<sup>st</sup> 5 Way\* vaccination  
1<sup>st</sup> West Nile vaccination  
Rabies vaccination

7-8 months old: 2<sup>nd</sup> 5 Way\* vaccination  
2<sup>nd</sup> West Nile vaccination  
Rabies vaccination  
Castration/Wolf Teeth removal

10-12 months old: 3<sup>rd</sup> 5 Way\* vaccination  
3<sup>rd</sup> West Nile vaccination

Yearly: Physical Examination  
5 Way\* vaccination (recommend in early spring)  
West Nile vaccination (recommend in early spring)  
Rabies vaccination  
Teeth Float  
Sheath Cleaning

Performance/Show Horses:  
(Increased Risk/Exposure) Yearly vaccination protocol  
6 month booster of Influenza & Rhino. vaccinations  
Strangles (Strep. equi.) vaccination bi-annually

Brood/Pregnant Mares: Yearly vaccination protocol  
Booster 5 Way\* & West Nile 4-6 wks prior to foaling  
EHV (anti-abortion vaccine) at months 5, 7, 9 of pregnancy

*Recommend intestinal parasite deworming with broad spectrum product every 4-5 months for adult horse*

### NUTRITION & CARE

- Have clean drinking water available at ALL times
- Feed a consistent, quality hay source as recommended
- Graining should be used as a supplement for an active or senior horse
- Routine feet trimming/shoeing should be performed by a qualified farrier
- Appropriate diet and exercise will lead to a better quality for your horse

\* 5 Way vaccination: Eastern Encephalitis, Western Encephalitis, Influenza, Rhinopneumonitis, Tetanus
